



Online Assessments for Introduction Courses

What to expect when you register for an Online Introduction Course Assessment:

- After paying the assessment fee online, you will be emailed log-in details to access LearnADR where the assessment is hosted directly from HQ
- The assessment consists of 60 multiple choice questions
- The questions are derived from the content within the course materials
- There will be a mock test for you to experiment with before you start the actual assessment
- You will have 3 attempts to take the actual assessment
- Each attempt allows you to start the assessment and resume where you left off for up to 7 days if you wish to finish it off later
- You will have 28 days from the assessment start date to complete the assessment
- Your result will be displayed immediately upon completion of the assessment
- Upon passing the assessment, you will be able to print your own certificate from LearnADR
- The pass mark is 55%

- The result is valid for Ciarb membership admission for a period of two (2) years from the date issued
- Upon successful completion you will be eligible to apply for Associate grade membership (ACI Arb) online: <https://www.ciarb.org/membership/routes-to-membership/>
- If you do not complete the assessment within 28 days or fail all 3 attempts, you will have to register and pay the €95 assessment fee again for the next available online assessment
